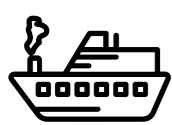

Local Flight

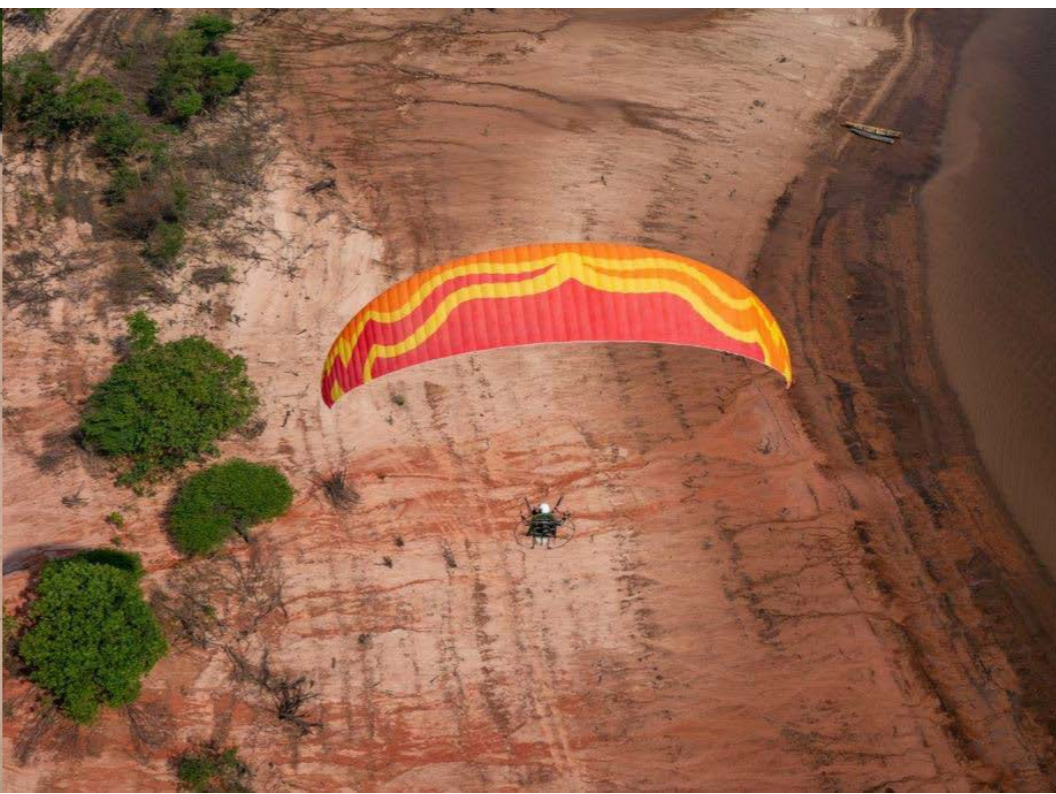
- Arrival at the boat & settling at the room

XC Flight 40km

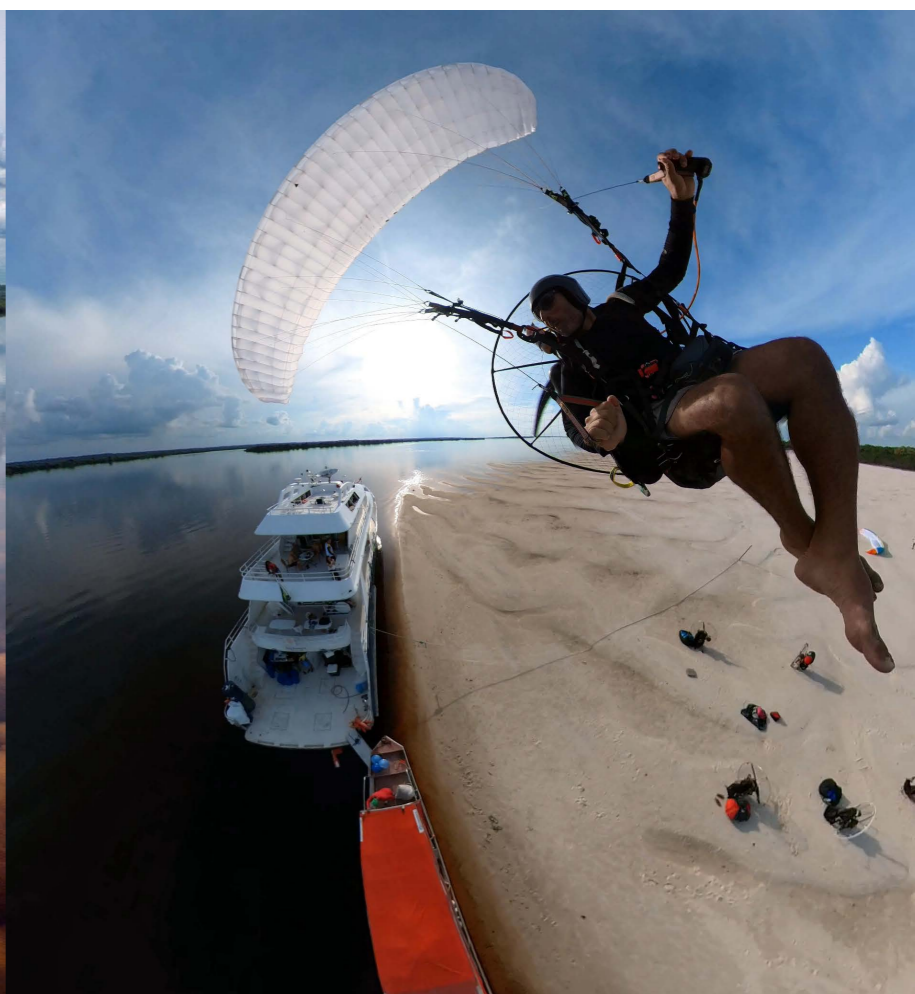
- Novo Airão to Praia das Gaivotas

XC Flight 40km

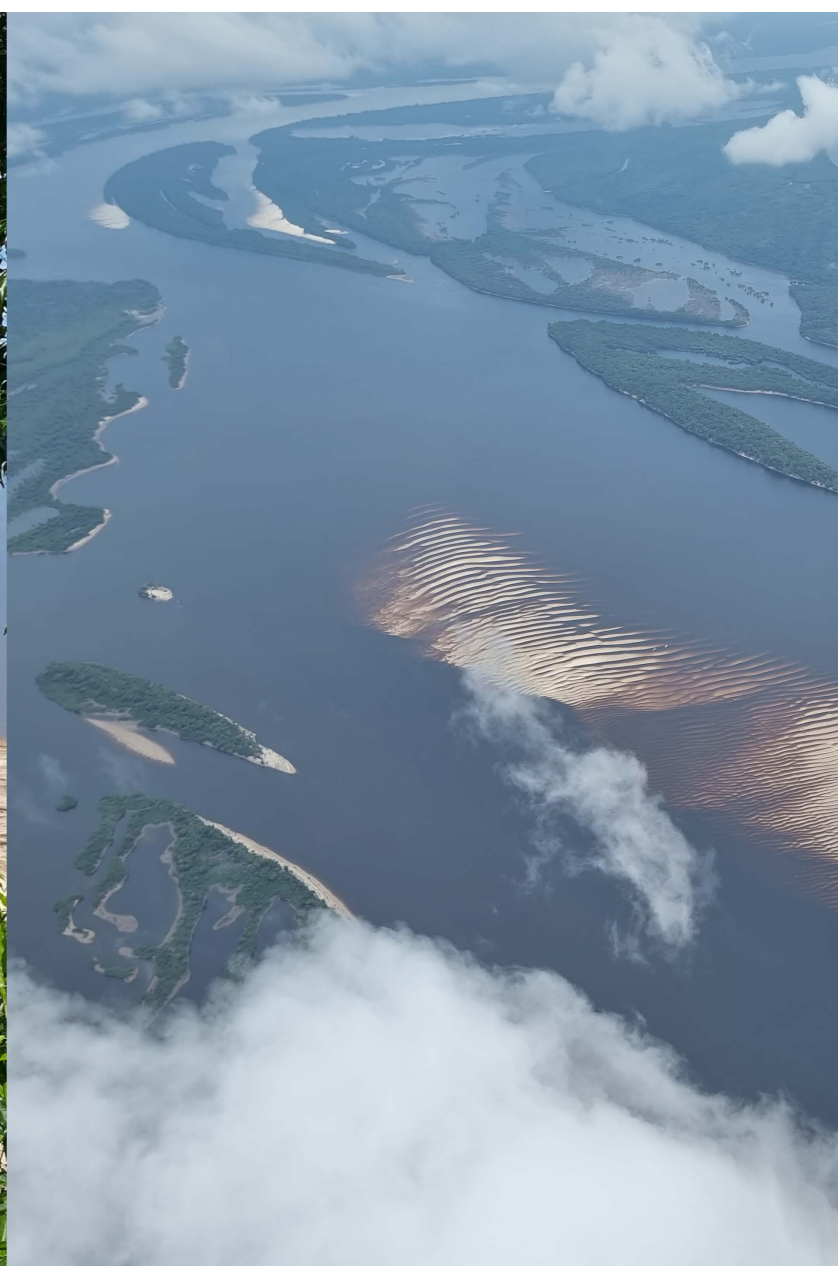
- Flight to Parana da Floresta sandbank

# DAY 8, 9, 10

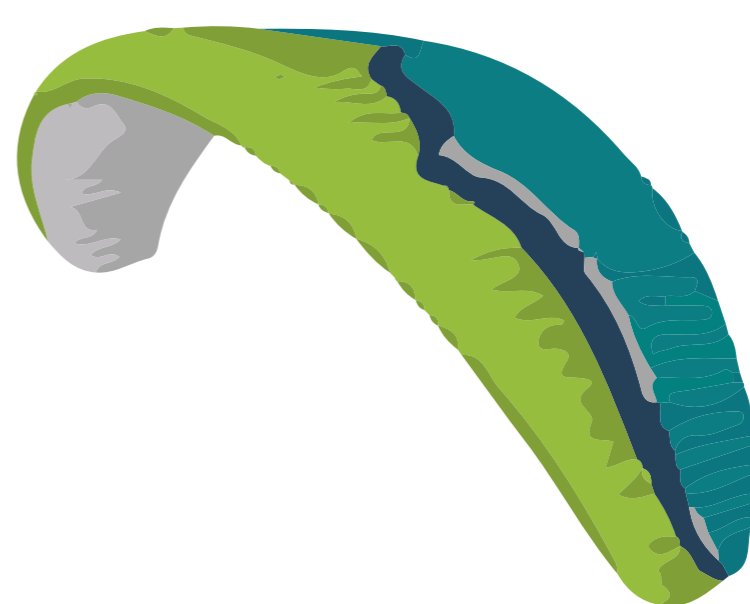
XC + Local Flight

- Slowly navigate back to Manaus. We will stop and fly whenever we can on new beaches.

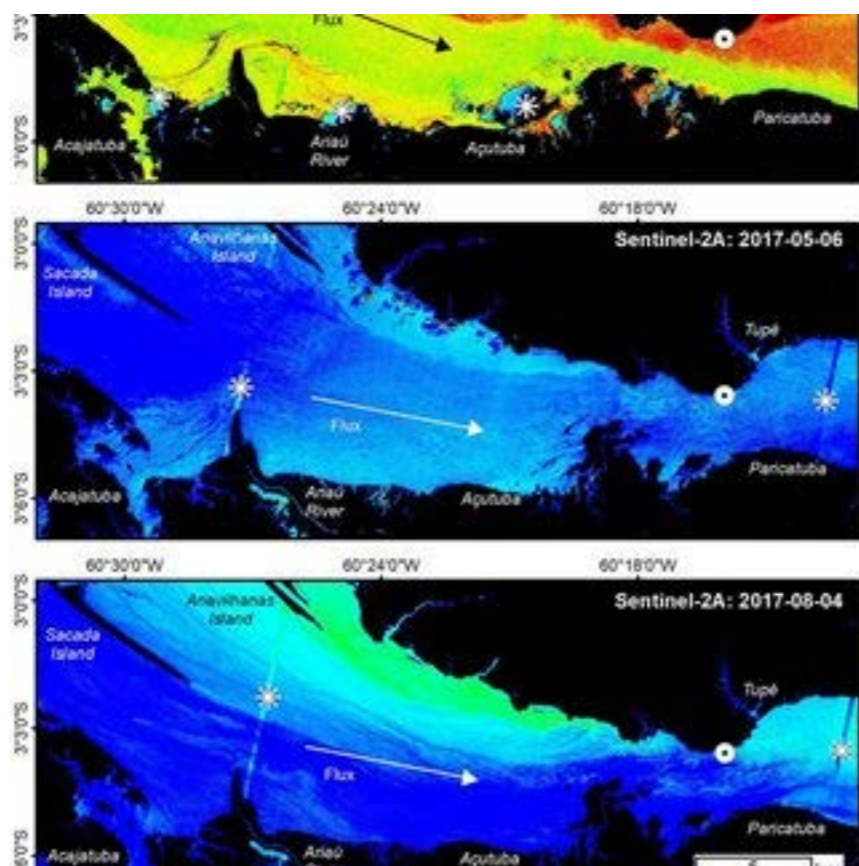


## WEATHER IN SEPTEMBER

During September, visitors to the Anavilhanas can expect the dry season weather to prevail until the end of October. The region experiences warmer temperatures ranging from 26°C to 32°C (79°F to 90°F) with relatively low precipitation and high humidity. The clearer skies during this period are conducive to outdoor activities and aerial exploration.

## Technical info about Anavilhanas:

The Anavilhanas Archipelago is significant for its seasonal dynamics, which influence the archipelago's river levels, weather, and wind patterns.

## WIND PATTERNS

The wind over the Anavilhanas is generally calm and predictable during the dry season, particularly beneficial for paramotoring. Early mornings and late afternoons see the calmest conditions, with gentle breezes that facilitate smooth flights. Pilots should still be mindful of occasional gusts that can precede rainstorms, even though they are less common in September.



The Rio Negro's water levels are at their nadir in September, revealing extensive sandbanks that provide ideal conditions for paramotor landing and takeoff. These exposed areas are not just critical for aviators but also create rich feeding grounds for a variety of wildlife, contributing to the archipelago's ecological diversity.

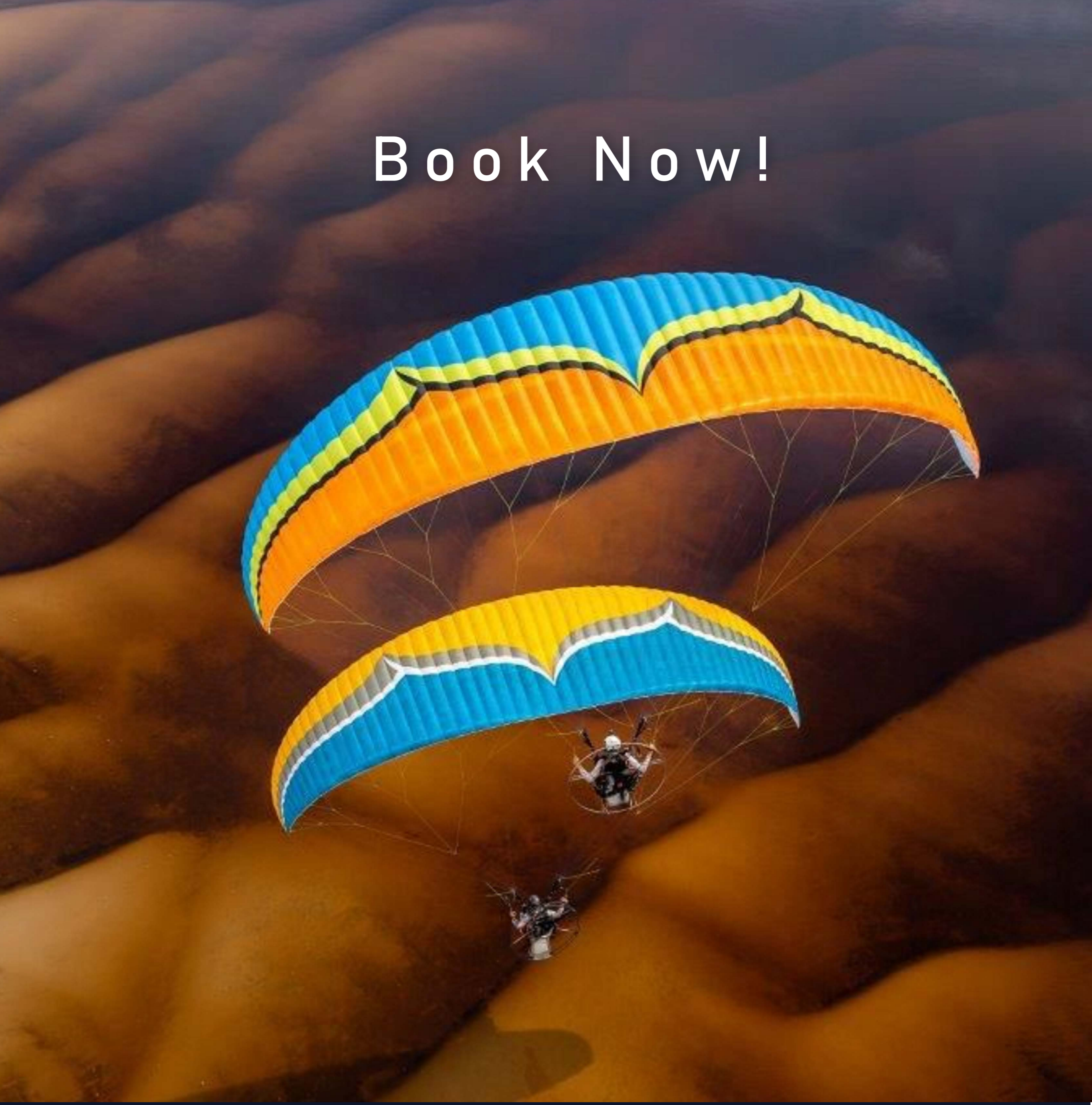
